# YEAR 12 STUDENTS DIVE INTO UCAT CAMP

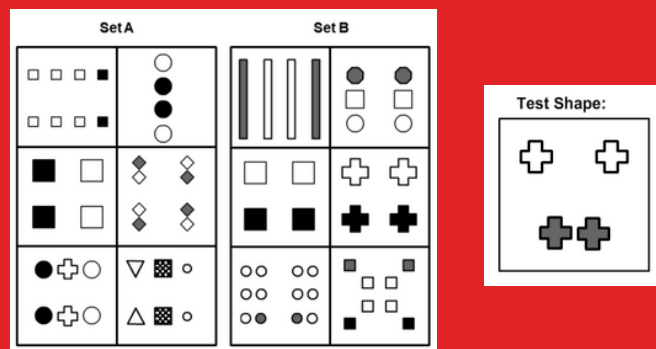
During the Summer term, Year 12 MeDeVet students will embark on preparations for aptitude tests required for Medical and Dentistry School admissions, such as the University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT). The UCAT serves as a crucial tool for universities in selecting candidates for interview invitations. It is designed to help Medical & Dental Schools differentiate between candidates, by testing their aptitude, attitude, decision making and professionalism to cope in a career in Medicine or Dentistry. It is an exam for aspiring doctors and dentists of tomorrow. A high score will help you obtain an interview.

In order to equip students with the tools for success, they will engage in a 10 week intensive course meticulously crafted and led by Andy Higham, Head of Science. This program is specifically designed to provide students with invaluable insights, offering practical tips and strategies tailored to the assessment they will face.

**Set A:** The lower images are a mirror-like reflection of the upper images – ie the line of symmetry is horizontal throughout set.

**Set B:** The images on the right are a mirror-like reflection of the images on the left – ie the line of symmetry is vertical throughout set.

**Correct response: B**
